## Rising 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Supply List 2023 - 2024

This is the list of supplies needed for 6<sup>th</sup> grade as of June 2023. There may be additional items requested at the beginning of the school year. Students will need to decide how they want to organize their binder/binders for their school day.   - 2 large boxes of tissue

  - 2 packs of copy paper
  - 400 sheets of wide rule loose leaf notebook paper
  - 1 rulers
  - 1 pack of highlighters
  - 1 pair adult scissors
  - 1 EXPO dry erase board eraser
  - 1 container of Clorox wipes
  - 1 pack of drinking straws
  - 1 bottle of Advil/Ibuprofen/Tylenol (pills) for **Nurse's Office**
  - 2 Black Sharpies ART
  - 1 pack of paper plates for **ART**
  - 2 pieces of white poster board for ART
