Supply List 2024 - 2025

This is the list of supplies needed for 8th grade as of June 2024. There may be additional items requested at the beginning of the school year. Students will need to decide how they want to organize their binder/binders for their school day. It is imperative that you make sure your student has paper and pencils **every** day **all** year long.

I. The first list is of items that your child will **KEEP** in his/her locker or book bag. These items could be organized in their binders or folders.

All 8th grade students are **required** to have these items:

- 1 or 2- two or three inch 3 ring binders according to the way your student will. organize their work
- Dividers for binders
- WIDE RULE loose-leaf notebook paper!!! (Keep some at home and in each binder.)
- Graph paper
- Pens (black or blue)
- Pencils and more pencils
- Pencil pouch for 3 ring binder
- Colored Pencils for personal use
- Hand-held pencil sharpener with compartment for shavings
- Poster Board at home
- NIV Bible with a concordance
- Highlighters
- 1 pair of ear buds for computer class (turn in to Mrs. Owens)
- TI-84 CE Graphing Calculator
(If you have an earlier model of the TI-84 graphing calculator, you do not need to purchase new one.)

II. The following supplies are to be turned in to the specified teacher on the first day of school.

- 1 3 ring binder if they plan to take **Drama**

III. The following supplies are to be turned in to the homeroom teacher on the first day of school.

- 2 boxes of tissue
- 3 rolls of paper towels
- 2 packs of copy paper
- 3 pieces of white full size poster board
- 1 pack colored markers
- 1 dry erase board eraser and board cleaner solution
- 2 rolls of scotch tape
- 1 container Clorox wipes
- 1 pack of Sharpie permanent markers
- 1 pack of craft sticks
- 1 reusable ice pack(soft pack for injuries) for **Nurses Office**
- 2 Bottles of Acrylic craft paint (Walmart/Michaels) any color **ART**
- 2 Pieces of black full size poster board **ART**
