We wrapped up our Ugandan Water Project by challenging our middle school students to walk a mile carrying a gallon (or more!) of water. The experience gave them a powerful glimpse into what many people around the world do every day just to bring water home.

Through their science classes, they've also been learning about the global water crisis and were amazed at how heavy the jerrycan—the container many Ugandans carry—can be.



A typical jerrycan is 20 liters, or about 5 gallons. (This one is much newer and cleaner than most in Africa)

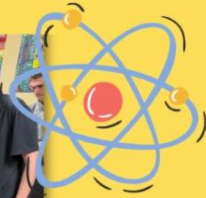


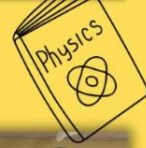
The high school physics class recently completed a unit on work, power, and energy by designing, building, and testing their own roller coasters.
