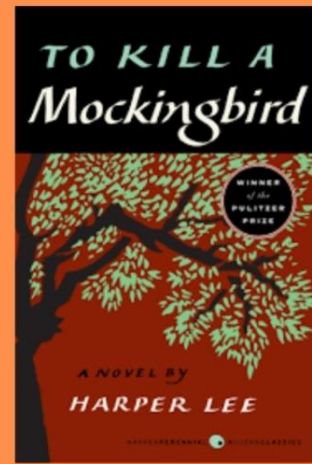




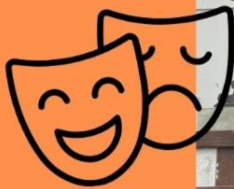
To support their Social Studies unit, the class visited Fort Moultrie to explore this Revolutionary War site for a first hand view of the setting and armaments used during this time period.

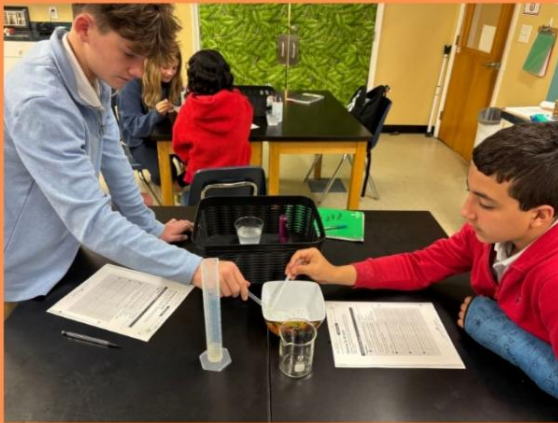


Using STEM to Solve Real World Problems

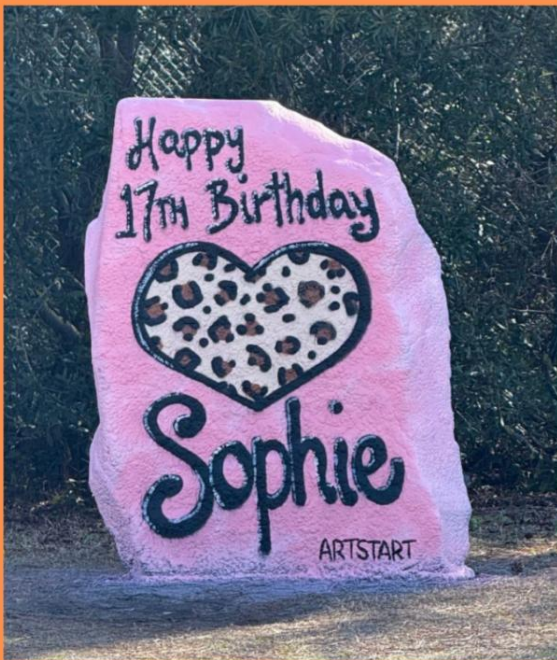
